

# BlackBerry Wireless Handheld Version 2.6 Service Pack 1 Release Notes

This document provides information about software version 2.6 Service Pack 1 for the RIM 950 Wireless Handheld™, RIM 957 Wireless Handheld™, RIM 850 Wireless Handheld™, and RIM 857 Wireless Handheld™.

## New features

- You can now view .zip and .html attachments on your handheld.



**Note:** To open file attachments with a .zip or .html file extension, the following additional requirement must be met:

- Your handheld must be enabled for attachment service on a BlackBerry Enterprise Server version 3.6 Service Pack 1 or later for Microsoft Exchange or a BlackBerry Enterprise Server version 2.2 Service Pack 1 or later for Lotus Domino.

## Fixed issues

This service pack contains the following fixed issues:

- Previously, when saving a search, you could not press a letter in the change option dialog box to specify the shortcut key.
- Previously, when filing a message from a personal folder to a regular folder on your handheld, the **Reconcile Now** option was

available. You cannot reconcile email messages in personal folders over the wireless network.

- Previously, in the **Go To** dialog box of the Browser application, if you cleared the field, `http://` was also cleared.
- Previously, if you deleted all prior messages on your handheld, tentative appointments were also deleted. The appointment was removed from your handheld calendar and, if you had wireless calendar synchronization enabled, the appointment was deleted from your desktop calendar. Now, when you delete all prior messages, tentative appointments are not deleted.
- Previously, if your handheld was enabled on a BlackBerry Enterprise Server which was not set up for wireless email reconciliation, after you synchronized your handheld with your desktop, the **Delete On** field of the Message List Options screen reverted to **Handheld**.
- Previously, when viewing some WML pages in the Browser application, the handheld reset.
- Previously, when viewing certain web sites, an Incomplete Entry error message appeared, even though information from the web page was available.
- Previously, hypertext links in angle brackets were not recognized as links.
- Previously, if your handheld is enabled on the BlackBerry Web Client, and, if, on the Message List Options screen, you changed the Wireless Reconcile field to **Off**, an error message appeared.
- Previously, some devices were unable to browse to URLs with a number sign in the address
- Changes were made to address an issue where IT Policy Settings were not updated correctly under specific circumstances.

## Known issues

- If the Messages screen extends beyond one screen, pressing the space key does not scroll down a page.
